Rules

- 1 Exhibits of fruit, flowers and vegetables must be exhibitors' own produce and entered in the name of the person on whose land they have been grown.
- 2 Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own vases, bowls, etc. and for removal after the show.
- 3 Exhibits may be staged on the evening before the show between 6.30pm and 7.30pm, OR on the morning from 8.45am to 10.00am.

** * *All entries must be in the Hall before 10am * * **

Rules continued . . .

- 4 Numbered tickets will be given to all exhibitors and names may NOT be attached until after judging has taken place.
- 5 Children to state age.
- 6 No exhibitor or anyone else will be allowed in the Hall during judging.
- 7 The Judges' decision will be final and they have the power to withhold or modify prizes for lack of merit or insufficient entries.
- 8 Carrots, beetroot must be exhibited carrying 2" - 3" foliage.
- 9 Photographs should be mounted.
- 10 Exhibitors in groups 1, 2 and 3 (Sections 1, 2 and 3) must state whether exhibit is being entered in OPEN or COTTAGER class.
- 11 On no account must exhibits be removed before 4.15pm. Prize money may be claimed after 3.30pm from the Treasurer in the Hall, but exhibits must not be touched.
- 12 Exhibitors not wishing to sell must remove goods before 4.30pm.

Prizes

Cottager's Class A Silver Challenge Cup will be presented to the Cottager with the most points in Groups 1, 2 and 3 (from Weston or Aston) and held for one year by the winner.

Open Class A silver Challenge Cup will be presented to the exhibitor in the Open classes with the most points in Groups 1, 2 and 3 and held for one year by the winner.

Henry Norton Cup This will be presented for the most points in the Flower section (Cottager or Open) and held by the winner for one year.

The Hon Mrs V Charteris Challenge Cup presented to the exhibitor of the best entry in the 'Decorative' section and held for one year.

The Roy Appleby Cup This Challenge Cup will be presented to the exhibitor with the best entry of a "Single Named Rose".

The *Robert Dow Plate* for most points in the photographic section.

Cookery A special award of five pounds will be given to the exhibitor with most points in this section.
