20/121	3. REPORTS FROM THE COUNTY AND DISTRICT COUNCILLORS: Notes from Cllr Gina Blomefield: Garden waste collection has resumed to the relief of many. The recycling centre is also now open at Fosse Cross with a booking system. Mondays and Tuesdays are the days with the most significant problems with collecting all the recycling so that is of course affecting us in the north Cotswolds. We are also a long way from the recycling centre at Cricklade so there is not enough time for the trucks to empty and return to collect the missed rubbish – generally cardboard. Please look at the website before calling to find out when your missed rubbish will be collected – generally the following day. The £29m of the money given to the CDC for business grants has been distributed – the CDC think there are more eligible business – if anyone knows of a business that receives Small Business Rate Relief or is in retail, hospitality or leisure business in a commercial property with a rateable value below £51,000 – please ask them to be in touch with the Finance team at CDC. There is a new Discretionary grant available to small businesses such as B&Bs, market traders (lock ups) and charities. The fund is small and applications will open on 1st June with just a two week window in which to apply. Understand maximum payout would be £10,000. The Council has trialled Planning and Licensing meetings with WebEx and also Oversight & Scrutiny – formal meetings are now planned. The Cabinet Meeting will be held virtually on 1st June with a Council ACM on 3rd June.
